## Information on Tuition Fee Waiver / Rebate for Students Affected by SEP Suspension Due to COVID-19

Information correct as at 30 March 2020

## <u>Scenario #1</u>

Tuition fees in Special Terms will be waived if your combined workload in Semester 2 and Special Term does not exceed the maximum of 23 MCs, and if you are not on LOA in Semester 2 or not reading normal workload in Semester 2.

## Scenario #2

If you are on LOA (suspension of SEP plan due to COVID-19) in Semester 2, AY2019/2020 with your tuition fee refunded, the semester will be excluded from the candidature period for tuition fee rebate. The candidature period applicable for fee rebate for the various types of degree programmes are as stipulated and defined in the table below:

S/N	Degree Type	Candidature Period for Fee Rebate*
1	Single Degree/Joint Degree Programme (120 MCs)	6 consecutive semesters
2	Single Degree/Joint Degree Programme (160 MCs)	8 consecutive semesters
3	Double Degree Programme (DDP)	9 consecutive semesters

\* The candidature period for fee rebate is defined here to include all approved Leave of Absence (LOA) periods, <u>excluding</u> those given for medical reasons and SEP suspension due to COVID-19.

A student is eligible to receive rebates under the Tuition Fee Rebate Policy if s/he meets <u>all</u> the following conditions:

- i) Admitted into an undergraduate degree under the **module system**<sup>#</sup> in NUS from AY2014/15 to AY2018/19;
- ii) Completed <u>NUS modules</u> during the following period(s):
  - **Prior to the undergraduate candidature** (e.g. NUS iBLOC, NUS H3 subjects, NUS modules taken as NUS High School students, and NUS modules taken under the Polytechnic Advanced Placement Programmes); and/or
  - During Special Terms <u>within</u> the undergraduate candidature;
- iii) Paid tuition fees <u>in excess</u> of the fees for completing the undergraduate degree programme on time in the <u>candidature period applicable for fee rebate</u>.

#Notes:

- The fee rebate policy <u>does not</u> apply to UG students admitted to Medicine / Dentistry / Law where the programme structure and duration are fixed (except Law DDP students whose 2nd degree is registered with a modular faculty).

- UG students admitted to Bachelor of Technology Programme and Yale-NUS College are also not eligible. The fee policies for these students are managed separately.

## Please note:

The Special Term modules that you enrolled remain <u>chargeable</u>. If you are eligible for a rebate, the University will make arrangements to credit the money to your bank account after you have fulfilled graduation requirements and have been conferred the degree.
